Assures that all youth can afford to belong. Membership dues are kept low at \$15 per year, so all young people can afford to join.

and youth. Hundreds of activities are available year-round and there's something for everyone.

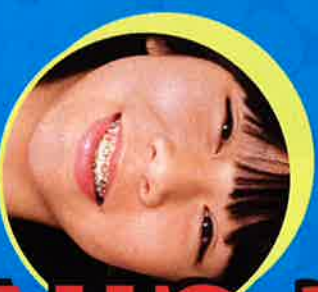
